We have contacted the Indian Shores and Pinellas County Police Tip line of this activity to alert them to issues possibly occurring to other buildings on Gulf Boulevard.

Sofia and Juan worked Monday-Thursday this week in order to have a three-day weekend beginning tomorrow for the holidays.

Watch for packages on the tables. If you see one still there in the afternoon, you may want to take them upstairs with you and notify the recipient that you have it. Especially during the weekends and Wednesdays when we do not have Sofia and Juan here.

The south garage gate needs a new motor and we are working to get it installed. The south garage door to the lobby has a code issue and we are trying to get it fixed. It is locked so no one can enter. They could; however, enter into the elevator then exit into the lobby.

The doors from the pool into the lobby have the same issue as does the gulf stairwell doors. These doors do not lock. On all of these doors, Ro is working to get it resolved.

As a precaution, keep your doors locked from the vestibule into your home. Also lock the balcony door since the stairwell can be accessed.
